



## REGRADING

Regrading your lawn levels sloping in the yard. The new grading should move water away from your home, as well as ensure you aren't directing water to your neighbor's property.

# **FRENCH DRAIN**




A French drain is a perforated pipe wrapped in fabric to prevent debris from causing a clog. It's set into a gravel trench to help remove water from overly saturated areas.

#### **CORRUGATED PIPE**



When well-installed gutters aren't doing enough to direct water away from your house, attaching a corrugated pipe can help. The pipe can be buried in the ground to send water in a particular direction.

### **RETAINING WALLS**



When installed properly, retaining walls can hold back soil and even help block or redirect water. They can be constructed out of many types of material.
